- ④ 72 Eight is equal to the quotient of a number and 9. Find the number.
- ⑤ 7 The difference of a number and three is equal to 4. What is the number?
- ⑥ 9 27 is equal to the product of three and some number. Find the number.
- ⑦ 35 Five is equal to the quotient of a number and 7. Find the number.
- ⑧ 11 The difference of a number and eight is equal to 3. What is the number?
- ⑨ 6 12 is equal to the product of two and some number. Find the number.
- ⑩ 15 Three is equal to the quotient of a number and 5. Find the number.
- ⑪ 10 The difference of a number and four is equal to 6. What is the number?
- ⑫ 5 50 is equal to the product of ten and some number. Find the number.
- ⑬ 10 Two is equal to the quotient of a number and 5. Find the number.
- ⑭ 11 The difference of a number and four is equal to 7. What is the number?
- ⑮ 8 24 is equal to the product of three and some number. Find the number.
